Do other work and then revisit your language notes. Just before going to bed, mentally review any vocabulary or new information you learned in class that day or the previous day; this will help you retain the information in your mind. Use your class time well It is expected that you attend class regularly and participate in all activities. Successful students practice a lot for each class period. When someone else is giving an answer for example, you are listening and mentally thinking of the correct pronunciation, structure, conjugation, etc. When there are five to ten minutes of extra time for practice or study, successful students use it.
